

5. A factory kept increasing its output by the same percentage every year. Find the percentage if it is known that the output is doubled in the last two years.
6. If the root of the equation $x^2 + 2cx + ab = 0$ are real unequal, prove that the equation $x^2 - 2(a+b)x + a^2 + b^2 + c^2 = 0$ has no real roots.
7. For what value of P are $2P+1, 13, 5P-3$ are three consecutive terms of an A.P.
8. If the sum of first P term of an A.P is $ap^2 + bp$, Find its G^{th} .
9. In an A.P the sum of first ten terms is -150 and the sum of its next ten terms is -550, find the A.P
10. In an A.P the first term is 2, the last term is 29 and the sum of the terms is 155. Find the common difference of the A.P.
11. A spiral is made up of successive semi-circles, with centre alternately at A and B starting with centre at A. of radii 0.5cm, 1.0cm, 1.5cm as shown in Fig. What is the total length of such a spiral made up of thirteen consecutive semi-circles? Take $\pi = 22/7$

12. The sum of $n, 2n, 3n$ of an AP are S_1, S_2, S_3 respectively. Prove that $S_3 = 3(S_2 - S_1)$
