(i) Select AVG(COST) from ITEMS;

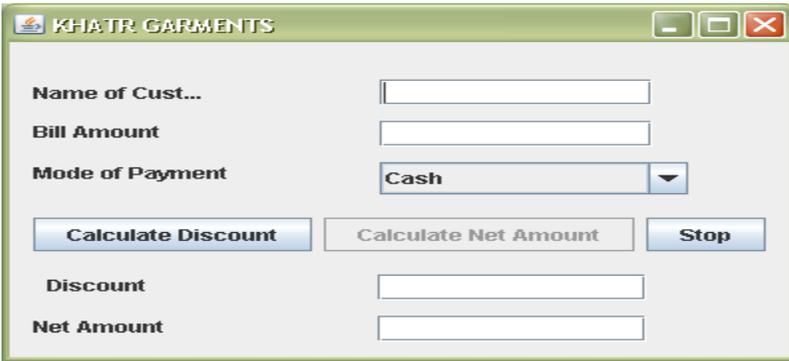
(ii) Select COST +100 from ITESM Where ITEM_NO >102;
