

A solid cone of base diameter 7cm and height 6cm is completely immersed in water. Find the volume of water displaced out of the cylindrical vessel and water left in cylindrical vessel.</p>	3
8.	<p>The sum of the squares of three positive numbers that are consecutive multiples of 5 is 725. Find the three numbers.</p>	3
9.	<p>The angles of depression of two ships from the top of a light house and on the same side of it are found to be <math>45^\circ</math> and <math>30^\circ</math>. If the ships are 200 m apart, find the height of the light house.</p>	3


12. A class teacher has the following absentee record of 40 students of a class for the whole term. Find the mean number of days a student was absent.

13. Radio towers are used for transmitting a range of communication services including radio and television. The tower will either act as an antenna itself or support one or more antennas on its structure, including microwave dishes. They are among the tallest human-made structures. There are 2 main types: guyed and self-supporting structures.

On a similar concept, a radio station tower was built in two sections *A* and *B*. Tower is supported by wires from a point *O*. Distance between the base of the tower and point *O* is 36 m. From point *O*, the angle of elevation of the top of section *B* is  $30^\circ$  and the angle of elevation of the top of section *A* is  $45^\circ$ . On the basis of given information answers the following questions.
